### ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES **MONDAY, APRIL 16, 2018** 7TH DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 16, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Presiding Commissioner Pickens signed a "Letter of Agency -Authorization to Access Telephone Provider Records". It will be sent to SpyGlass giving them authorization to access any and all customer service records, account information, contracts, long distance carrier information, pending order activity and/or any other information relevant to Adair County's local or long distance telecommunications service.

Commissioner King e-mailed Pat Williams Court Services Administrator - Second Judicial Circuit of Missouri regarding the status of Jane Moore, Drug Court Case Manager. He didn't think the County had any liability for this position. The e-mail reads as follows:

Commissioners: The new position suggested by the juvenile court administrator is NOT a County position or a County employee and there is no obligation for the County to carry that person as such. The employee works for the Court and as such is a state employee covered by the State Legal Defense Fund. It is our opinion that the settlement arrived at under the Judicial Finance Commission process resolved the issues as to personnel such as this employee. The Adair County Commission met for an update on the Ameren Transmission Line. Those present were as follows: Stephanie Muentnich, Volkert; Kami Mohn, Northeast Power; Annette Sweet, Ameren Missouri; Thomas Kohler, ATXI; Jim Jontry, ATXI; Leah Dettmers, ATXI; Chuck Twellmann, ATXI; and Todd Barnes, AECOM.

Thomas Kohler, ATXI, stated that the project is outage driven and plans to start May 2018 and be finished and go in service by May 2019. Ground breaking at the future Zachary Sub Station will be May 7th with equipment and buildings arriving in the fall. He said that we might see some right of way construction this summer beginning with foundations.

Second Commissioner Thompson told that the 63 Windfarm was going to be doing a 1 year study for wind energy.

Mr. Kohler went on to state that they have obtained about 25% of the right away and will continue to work with landowners to obtain the rest. Stephanie Muentnich, Volkert, said that the landowners are being very good to work with the surveyors. They are doing walking to research the right of way to determine the line. She said about 50 foundations will start in May, then further down the line the foundations will begin in the summer. Right now they are trying to find good access for concrete trucks.

She said that the culverts will be replaced as needed for access and the roads will be repaired. Damages that occur to the roads will be reported to Chuck Twellmann, ATXI, and Todd Barnes, AECOM, so they can see what needs to be done. Most repair will be completed by the County at ATXI expense. They are committed to restoration.


