

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 4, 2018
3RD DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 4, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, reported unofficial results for successful candidates and propositions and questions for the April 3, 2018 Adair County Municipal Election. They are as follows: Ambulance District Proposition for County Wide, Adair (Vote for 1): Shall the Adair County Ambulance District continue applying and collecting the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats and outboard motors purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer? Disapproval of this measure will result in a reduction of local revenue to provide for vital services for Adair County Citizens, and it will place Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, trailers, boats and outboard motors at a competitive disadvantage to non-licensed Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, trailers, boats and outboard motors. YES - 1,444 and NO – 250; School Board Directors for R-1 Novinger School District, Adair (Vote for 2) were Robin Carter - 124 and Sharon Barnes - 99; School Board Directors for Kirksville R-3 School District, Adair (Vote for 2) were Gay Jones Nichting – 997 and Michael A. Bishop, II - 890; School Board Directors for LaPlata R-2 School District, Adair (Vote for 2) were Jason Robinson – 19, and Brandon L. Mack - 18; Alderman At-Large for City of Brashear, Adair (Vote for 2) was Matt McKim – 14, Scott Niver (Write-In) – 1, and Shirlene Hettinger (Write-In)– 1; Alderman At-Large for City of Greentop, Adair (Vote for 2) was Sam Tarr – 2 and Stephen L. March – 2; Alderman At-Large for City of Novinger, Adair (Vote for 2) was Robert Stonecipher – 49 and Derrell Kimball - 42; Council Member for City of Kirksville, Adair (Vote for 1) was Phillip Biston – 687; Question for City of Novinger (Vote for 1): Shall the City of Novinger continue the 35-cent tax levy on one hundred dollars valuation for general municipal purposes for 4 years in the City of Novinger. (No tax increase). YES - 50 and NO - 7; Board of Trustees for Village of Gibbs (Vote for 2) were Jennifer Magruder (Write-In) – 4 and Lonnie Magruder (Write-In) - 4; and Board of Directors At Large for Adair County Nursing Home, dba Twin Pines Adult Care Center, Adair (Vote for 2) was Jim Bergman – 1,046 And Ed Smiser – 1,036.

The election is scheduled to be certified on Friday, April 6, 2017.


At 10:30 a.m., the Commission met in the office of the Schuyler County Commission to discuss a proposed wind farm project for Adair and Schuyler Counties. Present were Schuyler County Presiding Commissioner, Rodney Cooper; Associate Commissioner – South District, Jeff Lindquist; Associate Commissioner, North District, Jim Werner; Schuyler County Clerk, Bree Shaw; Adair County Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens; 1st District Commissioner, William King; 2nd District Commissioner, Mark Thompson; Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop; and Legal Counsel (for both counties) Ivan Schraeder of the Wagner Law Group.

Maps and working documents were supplied by Mr. Schraeder. General discussion regarding the proposed wind farm project was held and changes to the working documents taken into consideration.

Mr. Schraeder will make the proposed changes and send updated documentation back to the Counties by the end of the week. He requested that both Commissions contact him by Tuesday, April 10, 2018 with any additional changes.
