ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES MONDAY, JUNE 11, 2018 16TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 11, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At the recommendation of Nancy Pennington, Executive Director of the Adair County SB40) Developmental Disability Board, Commissioner King moved to renew the terms of Jeff Silvernail, Reverend Dale Stone, and Beverly Grubrich to the SB40 Developmental Disability Board. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Pickens concurred. All voted in favor of the motion. All three of the board member's current terms will renew on July 1, 2018. Their new terms will expire July 1, 2021.

At 10:30 a.m., Commissioner King moved to approve the Kirksville Kiwanis Club's use of the North Courthouse Parking Lot as of July 5, 2018. The Adair County Commission will support the use by the Kirksville Kiwanis Club on Saturday mornings from May through October indefinitely. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Pickens concurred. All voted in favor of the motion. The approval is due to the Adair County Commission terminating the "Concerning the Parking Lot use Agreement, dated June 4, 2001" with the City of Kirksville. The Adair County Commission will take over control of the parking lot on July 5, 2018.

At 10:45 a.m., the Commission met with members of Ameren, Missouri; Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI); and Northeast Power. The Commission meets monthly with these companies for an update regarding the progress of the Mark Twain Transmission Line.

Jim Jontry, ATXI, stated that the Zachary substation had been under construction for approximately one month. Equipment will arrive this fall and construction of the steel structure will begin. Entrances will be installed this summer or early fall. May, 2019, is the in-service date scheduled for the substation. The north line from the substation will begin in August of 2018.

Brett Farner, ATXI, said that nearly 60% of affected property owners from the new transmission line have signed agreements with them. They continue to negotiate with others. A letter is scheduled to be sent to land owners with whom they can't reach an agreement or who have not been not responsive. If attorneys are involved, they will be notified as well. A second letter will be mailed the last of June. All property owners are aware of eminent domain. ATXI did not want anyone to be surprised as they moved forward with the project. Property owners are responsible for legal counsel at their own expense. Mr. Farner stated that out of 142 land parcels, 130 were affected by utility lines and 12 for access only. Eighty-five percent had signed for right of entry. Land clearing will take place from November 1 thru March 31st due to an endangered species of bats within the area.

Commissioner Thompson mentioned that two employees of ATXI were not very nice to a property owner in the Brashear area. ATXI will attempt to check into the situation.
