

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**WEDNESDAY, JUNE 20, 2018**  
**21ST DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 20, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Pickens and Commissioner King were present. Commissioner Thompson was present until midafternoon.

At 2:52 p.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that this meeting be continued in closed session, with closed records and closed votes as permitted by law, for consideration of the following items as authorized by section 610.021(17) of the Missouri statutes:

Discussion under Subsection 17 of the statute for “confidential or privileged communications between a public governmental body and its auditor, including all auditor work product; however, all final audit reports issued but the auditor are to be considered open records pursuant to the chapter; ... ”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the doors of the Commission office. Present at the meeting were Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens; 1<sup>st</sup> District Commissioner, William King; Missouri State Auditor, Richard Stuck; and Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop.

So motioned by Commissioner King and seconded by Presiding Commissioner Pickens. Both voted in favor of the motion at 2:52 p.m. on Wednesday, June 20, 2018.

Closed session ended at 3:15 p.m.

The Commission spent the remainder of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 20, 2018.


