At 10:00 a.m., Commissioner King moved to amend Ordinance No. 2017-2 (Stop Sign Intersections) to include Twin Oaks/Banner Lane and to list all intersections where the stop sign is located. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Both voted in favor of the motion.

The Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 6, 2018.

<p style="text-align: center;">COUNTY OF ADAIR, MISSOURI ORDINANCE NO. 2017-2 (Amended June 06, 2018)</p> <p>An ordinance of the County of Adair, Missouri for stop intersections in accordance with Missouri Revised Statute 49.266;</p> <p>WHEREAS, except when directed to proceed by a law enforcement officer, every driver of a vehicle approaching a stop intersection, indicated by a stop sign, shall stop at a clearly marked stop line; but</p> <p>WHEREAS, if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or if none then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic in the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection; and</p> <p>WHEREAS, after having stopped, the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle which has entered the intersection from another roadway or which is approaching so closely on the roadway as to constitute an immediate hazard during the time when such driver is moving across or within the intersection.</p> <p>1. All stop intersections must be approved by the Adair County Commission.</p> <p>2. No such stop intersection will be considered unless 12 signatures of residents residing in the township where the intersection is located, or unless the intersection is deemed a hazard by the Sheriff of Adair County or the Adair County Commission. All stop intersections already in place prior to this ordinance being placed into effect are grandfathered in.</p> <p>3. All stop intersections already in place prior to this ordinance being placed into effect are grandfathered in.</p> <p>Approved stop intersections include:</p> <table style="width: 100%; border: none;"> <tr> <td style="width: 80%;">1.
