MONDAY, DECEMBER 31, 2018

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on December 31, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner King and Commissioner Thompson were present. Presiding Commissioner Pickens was absent.

Commissioner Thompson moved to transfer \$51,627 from General Revenue-Transfers Out 101-5-025-500.000 to Assessor-Transfer In from General Revenue 202-4-000-700.100. Commissioner King seconded the motion. Both voted in favor of the motion. The transfer will complete the amount budgeted in the 2018 budget to satisfy the statutorily mandated three year average of funds from General Revenue to the Assessment Fund.

The Commission spent the day attending to County business.
