TUESDAY, DECEMBER 4, 2018

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on December 4, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission conducted bid openings for the 2019 Adair County property and casualty insurance. Commissioner Pickens opened and read aloud the only bid received. The bid was from Daniel and Henry Co.in the amount of \$118,557.

The bid was reviewed and discussed. Commissioner King then moved to accept the bid from Daniel and Henry Co.in the amount of \$118,557 for 2019 property and casualty insurance. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner concurred. All voted in favor of the motion. Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, will notify representatives from Daniel and Henry Co. they were the successful bidder.

The Commission wrote a press release regarding the decision to re-instate the General Revenue Tax Levy in order to maintain adequate funds in General Revenue.

Many years ago, the Adair County Commission made the decision to voluntarily reduce the existing General Revenue Levy to zero percent. Recently after conversations with the Missouri State Tax Commission and the Missouri State Auditor's Office, the County Commission was advised that they should consider re-instating the General Revenue Tax Levy in order to maintain adequate funds in the General Revenue. With guidance from the Missouri State Auditor's Office, the County reinstated the levy with the required rollback reduction due to sales tax revenues. Proper notice was given before any changes were made.
