- 1) Take care of the transportation system and services we enjoy today
- 2) Keep all travelers safe, no matter the mode of transportation
- 3) Invest in projects that spur economic growth and create jobs
- 4) Give Missourians better transportation choices (more viable urban and rural transit, friendlier bike and pedestrian accommodations, improvements in rail, ports and airport operations.)

Mrs. Gough stated there is going to be a proposal for a 1percent sales tax to be placed on the ballot in November. The proceeds of the tax if passed, would give 90% of the proceeds to MoDOT, 5% to the Counties, and 5% to the Cities. This money would be separate from BRO federal funds. She stated that the fuel tax was going down.

It is anticipated that the sales tax would provide 700 million dollars in revenue each year. The proceeds would be governed by six commissioners appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. It would be comprised of three Democrats and three Republicans each serving a six year term. Mrs. Gough stated that they have received 1000 projects for the Northeast District.

Commissioner Adams said that it was a band aid for the Counties and was a slap in the face by receiving only 5% of the revenue. He said that many County roads were deteriorating. Mrs. Gough stated that was a fair concern to have. She said MoDOT had to do what they could to take care of the system.

She continued by saying they were ready for the winter. And she was happy that Mrs. Crawford had a good relationship with the County. Commissioner Thompson stated that MoDOT was now more "user friendly" than in the past. In conclusion, they said MoDOT would be contacting the County in severe storms.

The Commission spent the rest of day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on December 2, 2013.
