Mr. Williams had been told that the State Legal Expense Fund could insure the vehicles for liability coverage.

Commissioner Adams moved to go forward in purchasing a County vehicle for use in the Public Administrator's office. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Pickens abstained from the vote. The vehicle will be purchased from Machens in Columbia, Missouri as they currently have the pre-approved State bid for the purchase.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on February 17, 2016.
