ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES MONDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2015 1ST DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on February 2, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner Adams and Commissioner Thompson were present. Commissioner Pickens was out of the office.

The Commission received a fully executed Intergovernmental Agreement adopted by Adair, Knox and Lewis Counties related to the 2nd Judicial Circuit Court and its budgets. The document is to be filed with the County Clerk's office and will govern the budgets of the Circuit Court through 2020.

Commissioner Adams moved to transfer \$4,527.08 from the Juvenile Salaries Fund (formerly Juvenile Grant Operations 909-5-003-100.000) to Juvenile Justice Fund (907-4-000-007.100) in order to comply with the 2nd Judicial Settlement Agreement. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. This clears all excess 2014 monies from the Juvenile Salaries Fund.

Commissioner Adams moved to transfer \$43,341.65 from the Juvenile Justice Fund (907-5-004-200.000) to General Revenue Fund (101-4-000-700.703) in order to comply with the 2nd Judicial Settlement Agreement. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. This clears all excess 2014 monies from the Juvenile Justice fund as of 1-30.15.

Adair, Knox, and Lewis Counties each contributed their proportionate share of \$25,000 to the 2nd Judicial Circuit as agreed to in the December, 2014, Settlement Agreement. This was comprised of \$2,585.00 (10.34%) for Knox County; \$6,390.00 (25.56%) for Lewis County; and the remainder of \$16,025.00 (64.10%) for Adair County as per the Intergovernmental Agreement – 2nd Judicial Circuit Court Budgets, created as a result of the December, 2014 Settlement Agreement.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on February 2, 2015.
