At 1:30 p.m., the Commission met with Jami Livingston, Director of the Adair County Library, and board member, Adam Dorrell. The 2016 library budget was reviewed and details of the 2017 budget were presented and discussed. Mrs. Livingston spoke of the accomplishments achieved during 2016. These included; 175,434 items had been checked out; 1274 canned goods were collected and given to the food pantry; 1275 new library cards were issued; 1156 items were loaned to other libraries; and the "Friends of the Library" helped to fund the children's summer reading program, purchased button making materials for the children's library, and sponsored a "Tea" for the library volunteers.

They stated the computers were greatly utilized for projects such as applying for jobs online. They restrict use to one hour except for testing and job obligations. There are filters on the computers for public safety. They praised their impressive staff of volunteers that include members of the Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP), Truman State University students, as well as many others. 149 volunteers provided 3372.6 hours of service.

The Commission thanked Mrs. Livingston and Mr. Dorrell for the information.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on February 21, 2017.
