

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2013**

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Commissioner Thompson stated he was working with Charles Nelson of the State Emergency Management Agency to complete documentation to be reimbursed for previous disasters that have occurred within the County. Costs are being clarified and documentation is being gathered to support the reimbursement asked for by the County.

At the request of Matt Holt, Court Services Administrator, Commissioner Thompson moved to transfer \$16,770.54 from Juvenile Justice Center – Transfer to PA Admin account (907-5-003-902.300) to PA Administration – Transfers In – JJC for Drug Ct. Employee (903-4-000-700.100). Commissioner Pickens seconded the motion. Commissioner Adams was not present.

Chad Miller called the Commission to report that a County road grader had damaged his mailbox. It was determined that there wasn't any precedence to reimburse Mr. Miller for the damages.

At the request of Adair County Collector, David O. Erwin, the Commission agreed to increase the chargeable limit on US Bank credit card for the County Collector to \$10,000. The increase was requested to cover the cost of pre-stamped first class mailing envelopes used by the Collector's office and ordered from the US Postal Service. The cost for a normal order of the envelopes exceeds his present chargeable limit. The Commission approved Mr. Erwin's request.


The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.
