7TH DAY JANUARY REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on January 18, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner King was present. Commissioner Thompson was attending a the CCAM State Board Legislative meeting in Jefferson City, and Presiding Commissioner Pickens was present in the morning and then traveled to Memphis, Missouri to attend the Northeast Regional Planning Commission meeting in Memphis during the afternoon.

Commissioner King moved to allow a one-time exception for employees of the Child Support Services grant to receive payroll benefits without the fully executed contract being on filed in the County. Presiding Commissioner Pickens seconded the motion. Both were in favor of the motion. Per Adair County Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson, the contract is nearing completion and will then be sent to the State for approval.

The proposed 2017 Budget continued to be reviewed.
