Mr. Rhoads and Mr. Smith said they were glad to be able to work with the local Commission. Commissioner Thompson stated that they were pleased to work with local contractors and more than pleased to have them work on this fine building. The Commission complimented Mr. Martin on his handling of this project.

Discussion was held regarding the payout of the \$128,000 grant awarded to Adair County for the project. The grant is 60/40 with \$76,800 from the Federal Government and \$51,200 being the responsibility of the County. A monthly meeting will be held for progress reports and payment scheduling. Sandra Collop, Adair County Clerk, stated that payments are made the 15th day and the last working day of the month. Mr. Martin will provide a payment schedule for everyone.

Associate Circuit Judge, Kristie Swaim, arrived to ask questions concerning the time frame of the work. It was estimated that work would begin sometime in April. This would allow PSR Construction time to obtain their materials. Discussion was held regarding Court scheduling during this time. Mr. Martin stated that plaster work would need to be completed in the Courtroom after repairs. The contractors will communicate with Linda Decker, Adair County Circuit Clerk, regarding Court scheduling and the Commission will communicate with elected officials who have offices within the Courthouse pertaining to everyday work.

The Commission thanked everyone for attending.

Arrangements have been made with Brian Noe, Adair County Coroner, regarding the burial of Willis Meredith AKA Jake Stedman. Mr. Meredith's body was discovered on January 6, 2013, at Village 76 Apartments in Kirksville. Jim Parker has been hired to open and close the grave.

The public hearing for the final approval of the 2013 Adair County budget was held from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the Commissioner's Suite on the second floor of the Courthouse. Members of the public did not attend. Mr. Mueller of the Kirksville Daily Express requested a copy of the new budget.

At 4:00 p.m., Commissioner Adams moved to approve the 2013 Adair County budget. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion with all in favor. Mrs. Collop will e-mail the document as well as overnight the paper document to the Missouri State Auditor's office for arrival before the January 31st deadline.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on January 28, 2013.


