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Mrs. Collop asked if there was a claim against those personal items. Mr. Rouner said there wasn't a claim against those items.

Mr. Rouner said your questions were well received and this process was certainly educational in its nature. He told Mrs. Collop I can understand you're frustrated with the way we handled it and again I'm sorry. The most I can say is I was trying to help. You're welcome to visit with Ron and he'll tell you the exact same thing, that we had an issue with the County car.

Commissioner Pickens said he couldn't believe Ron didn't call us. We had just worked out all the insurance for the County.

Mr. Rouner stated just to be clear, I've never handled an insurance claim before, and you've (Mr. Hall) never handled an insurance claim before. Mr. Hall stated that's why he thought having Mr. Rouner here would be more helpful than himself.

Commissioner Adams stated he was glad both of them came to the meeting.

Mr. Hall continued saying that's why I'm saying that, I think there are more questions he can answer than me. That is truly why I thought it would be helpful for him to be here. I think if I had come by myself you all would still have more questions.

Mr. Rouner stated that you asked about the log book stuff yesterday, and who had custody, and what it's used for and I don't know.

Mrs. Collop said that information that would tell who was responsible for the car.

Commissioner Pickens asked who was actually now in charge out at the Juvenile Justice Center.

Mr. Rouner replied that's a great question. I think Mr. Hall and I are jointly responsible for some day to day things, but right now it would be the Presiding Judge.

Mrs. Collop thought it may be a long term problem if the keys were continually left in the car or if it was only a onetime thing.

Mr. Rouner assured that some procedures of those type will certainly be addressed in the future if those were, in fact, issues. Best not talk about that when nobody can put their finger on exactly what occurred, but those things will most certainly be addressed in the future.

Commissioner Pickens asked if the two of them were running the Juvenile Justice Center right now.

Mr. Rouner said that might be an over statement. If you want to ask who is in charge that would be the Circuit Judge. So that's who is in charge.
