

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2015

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Commissioner Thompson said these questions were somewhat simple, so we thought you could answer most of them. But since you wanted to bring him (Rouner) along that was fine.

Mr. Hall said he thought it would be helpful. He had kind of turned that insurance part over to him, so that's why I thought having him here would be helpful.

Mrs. Decker again said she was just concerned Juvenile documents had been left in any vehicle.

Mr. Rouner said I think it says on the licensing and that log that says Juvenile Office on it.

Mrs. Decker said that the police report indicated that there were Juvenile documents in the car. The police report indicated that the person that stole the car had the car for well over a week. That's discerning. I assume nothing. I have always been a cover for my own particular office because of my conflicting nature with the Circuit Judge. I didn't believe so, but I just thought for any Circuit Clerk that's concerning. I have even deemed some documents un-certifiable that were moved from the Courthouse without my direction by Judge Steele. They will never be certified by a Circuit Clerk again. Any documents that are out there like that are a concern for any Circuit Clerk. While I'm speaking, not even on behalf of Adair County, but if they identify those, I want some assurance that they are going to notify the Circuit Clerks in those counties that those documents had been in the car for a week or longer. I think it's just prudent to do. Has somebody made copies and distribute them. Probably not, but it's a concern.

Mr. Rouner stated he didn't think there would be any court documents, but I thought it was worth checking in to.

Mrs. Decker stated if you've got a smart phone in there for a week or more, somebody has to catch that, let's be real.

Mr. Rouner didn't know if that was a current phone in use.

Mr. Rouner told Jeff he thought they could follow up with the Juvenile documents just to verify what exactly they were.

Mrs. Decker stated that her concern as the Circuit Clerk was that she had an issue with files that were moved without her consent and those couldn't be certified. If there were documents, then another Circuit Clerk should be notified. Certification or anything with those documents was a concern if they have been out in a vehicle for a week or more.

Commissioner Thompson said we had some questions and concerns and we appreciate you coming in.

Mr. Rouner said we're here so there will never be an issue with that. We thank you guys for your time.

Mrs. Collop said she would still like to know where the car was.
