

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, JULY 24, 2013
12TH DAY JULY REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on July 24, 2013 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. 1st District Commissioner Carson Adams and 2nd District Commissioner Mark Thompson were present. Presiding Commissioner Pickens was out of town.

The Commission met with Aaron McVicker from Shaffer, Kline, and Warren, and Ron Watts from the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDot) to discuss BRO funds. During the meeting, the Commission learned that BRO balances were incorrect and MoDot was checking to find where the discrepancies were.

Amy Crawford from MoDot stopped by to discuss the "On The Move Program". It was determined that 4 topics were priority. These include Maintenance, Safety, Economic Development, and Alternative Transportation Modes. The Commission also asked about obtaining cold patch supplies for the Road and Bridge Department.


Commissioner Thompson spoke with Ed Hiatt, the Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) Central Regulator of the Airport Division, about concerns regarding structures being built in the area around the Kirksville airport. Mr. Ed Hiatt provided a website regarding obstruction where Commissioner Thompson could obtain the information he needed.

The Commission discussed the closing of Loeffler Store Trail with Adair County Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson. The road was originally closed on April 1, 2013, and questions have been raised as to whether or not proper procedure was followed to close the road. Based on Mr. Wilson's legal opinion, the Commission elected to remain with the road closure.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on July 24, 2013.
