## ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES TUESDAY, JULY 29, 2014

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At 1:30 p.m., the Commission met with Kathleen Lear, Comptroller, of the Missouri State Public Defender's office. Ms. Lear presented an addendum to the lease between Lessor - Crist Properties, LLC and Lessee – the Counties of Adair, Schuyler, Scotland, and Knox for an additional three years over what is now in effect. The cost of rent for one year will increase to \$18,000 for the above Counties. Adair County's 64.89% portion will increase to \$11,680.29 or quarterly payments of \$2,920.07. The Public Defender's office is asking for renovations to the building in order to accommodate staff that has grown by more than 50% since the execution of the original lease. The increase will begin in January, 2015.

Commissioner Pickens, Commissioner Adams, and Commissioner Thompson all signed the lease. A signed copy with all parties involved will be returned to the County at a later date.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on July 29, 2014.
