

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

TUESDAY, JULY 3, 2012 2ND DAY JULY REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30a.m. on July 3, 2012 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Louann Rongey of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and her student intern, Simone. The Commission had asked Mrs. Rongey to explore grant opportunities to assist with restorative projects of the Adair County Courthouse.

Mrs. Rongey stated that Adair County would be 15% grant eligible for a project. That was based on the population and the median household income of the County. The grant application period would begin on October 1, 2012 and continue thru September 30, 2013. If awarded, the USDA could finance the remaining 85% of the grant with the purchase of bonds which is currently at a rate of 3 3/8%. Mrs. Rongey stated that the rate changed quarterly and would not be locked in until the grant was actually approved. There would not be a pre-payment penalty.

The Commission asked Mrs. Rongey to get an application packet together. She suggested that this be completed at their earliest possible convenience. Last year, their office was allotted \$35,000 to assist with projects that expanded over a 19 county area.

The Commission reported that Frank Oberle called concerning getting the situation resolved with the Adair County Humane Society.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission will reconvene on Monday, July 9 at 8:30a.m. The Courthouse will be closed on Wednesday, July 4, 2012, in honor of the Holiday.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00p.m. on July 3, 2012. IN
