

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 10, 2015
17TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 10, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 10:00 a.m., a bid opening was conducted for 2015 fuel prices for the Adair County sheriff's Department. Present along with the Commission were Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick, and Sheriff Department Finance coordinator, Dave Hurt. The County Clerk opened the only bid received. MFA Oil Company bid 3 cents under pump price. Sheriff Hardwick did not want to go thru the bidding process again and recommended the bid be awarded to MFA. Commissioner Thompson moved to award the bid to MFA Oil Company. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. The contract will be in effect from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.


