

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12, 2013
17TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 12, 2013 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Dan Hamlet who introduced himself as the new director of the Missouri Rural Enterprise and Innovation Center (MERIC). Mr. Hamlet is replacing Charlene Boyles who left the area to explore other employment opportunities.

The Commission reported that the 30' x 52' x 10' storage building erected by Lancaster Lumber at the Road and Bridge Department has been completed. All Commissioners have inspected the building. Commissioner Adams moved to accept the storage building with change order inclusive and make payment to Lancaster Lumber in the amount of \$21,797.00. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion with all in favor.




The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.
