

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 29, 2016  
23RD DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 29, 2016 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission reviewed and approved the sales contract prepared by Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, for the sale of two cars, one pickup, and two trailers to the Juvenile Justice Center. These vehicles were in possession of the Juvenile Justice Center but owned by Adair County. The document was reviewed and approved by Adair County's legal counsel. Pat Williams, Court Services Administrator for the Juvenile Justice Center, reviewed and approved the document. He stated that Judge Steele was also in agreement.

The Commission signed the document and Pat Williams picked it up to obtain Judge Steele's signature. It was soon returned with the signature. Both parties will have a signed original document.






In addition, the Second Judicial Circuit agrees to pay the insurance premium from January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 for the entire Juvenile fleet that has been in their possession but owned by Adair County. The cost is \$2,780.00.	
All Juvenile Office employees will be deleted from insurance coverage from Adair County's list of eligible drivers.	
Total amount due to Adair County is \$16,780.00.
