ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3, 2015 14TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 3, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission attended the Adair County family YMCA Advocacy Breakfast. Immediately following was the naming ceremony of the All Abilities Playground that will be built on property owned by the YMCA. The new playground has been named the "Kiwanis Playground in honor of Shag Grossnickle and Harvey Young." Mr. Grossnickle, with 71 years, and Mr. Young, with 70 years, are two of the longest serving members of the Kirksville Kiwanis Club.

The Commission met with Skip Wilson from PSBA – Engineers, Architects, Surveyors, and GIS. He gave the Commission an update on their work in surrounding communities.

The Commission met with Isiah Curtis, Road and Bridge Supervisor; Chris Akright, of Altorfer Equipment; and Matt Bartell of Equipment Financing to discuss the purchase of an excavator.

Mr. Akright provided a proposal for 1 new caterpillar 316E L Excavator which included standard equipment and options. He told the Commission that the selling price was \$204,755.00 and the County would receive \$49,755.00 for a trade in making a final sales price of \$155,000.00. These figures were based on the State of Missouri bid sheet.

Second District Commissioner, Mark Thompson, moved to purchase the excavator. First District Commissioner, Carson Adams, seconded the motion with Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens, being in favor. A purchase agreement was then entered into with Altofer, Inc.

Road and Bridge Supervisor, Isaiah Curtis, told Mr. Akright that the County also wanted to purchase a 430 Backhoe. He said the County planned to replace two backhoes they currently own. Once the new equipment was purchased, the County would sell the replaced backhoes.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 3, 2015.
