The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 30, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 10:00 a.m. the Commission met with the Sheriff's Department to award the bid for the jail door/lock maintenance contract. Those present along with the Commission was the Sheriff Department's finance officer, Dave Hurt. Mr. Hurt recommended the bid be awarded to Integrity Steel Works, Inc. Commissioner Thompson made a motion in favor of the recommendation. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. Integrity Steel Works, Inc. will be notified of the bid award. The contract period will be 7-1-15 thru 7-31-15. Bids were opened for this project on June 24, 2015.

Mr. Hurt presented the Commission with the 2015-2016 Deputy Sheriff Salary Supplemental Fund (DSSF) grant paperwork. The grant has already been applied for and approved. The Commission will sign the contract and certified assurances to accept the grant. Commissioner Thompson made a motion in favor. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. Mr. Hurt will supply the County Clerk's office with a copy of the completed contract as soon as he receives the final paperwork from the State.

Mr. Hurt informed the Commission that the program recently discussed with the Sheriff is currently on hold until they can do some more research. Commissioner Adams gave him a copy of the letter that had been prepared if the Sheriff had continued to pursue funding; plus a copy of the findings that had been compiled from other Counties on their procedures.

The County received a check from the City of Kirksville in the amount of \$15,440.00. The City of Kirksville has agreed to pay for 30% of the cost for new photographic images of the County for Geographic Information Software (GIS). The costs will be spread out over three years at approximately \$15,000 per year. The completed Memorandum of Understanding was received in the County Clerk's Office on May 29, 2015.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 30, 2015.
