

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**MONDAY, JUNE 30, 2014**  
**26TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 30, 2014 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission received a signed original contract form that covers the engineering service contracts assigned to Howe Company from Benton & Associates, Inc. Proof of commercial liability insurance and proof of professional liability insurance (which had already been submitted) was also enclosed. Mr. Howe severed his ties with Benton & Associates on June 13, 2014. Howe Company will be completing all Adair County bridge projects for engineering of the design and construction phase of all contracts Benton & Associates previously had signed with Adair County.

Kevin James, Assistant District Engineer for District 2 – North Central and Amy Crawford, Area Engineer – North Region, both from the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) dropped by to ask the Commission to write or e-mail a letter of support for adding the project to build an overpass at Highway 6 on the Highway 63 corridor. They wanted to verify that the overpass at Highway 6 was the Commission's choice as the project to add to MoDOT's project list for the Northeast District. The project list is contingent on Constitutional Amendment 7 passing the August 5, 2014 primary election.

At 2:00 p.m., the Commission conducted the bid opening for boiler replacement in the Adair County Courthouse. Present along with the Commission were Joe Nicol, Maintenance Foreman; John Hanley, Boston John Heating and Cooling; Charles Cooper of Countryside Service; and Jerry Caldwell.

The bids were opened and read aloud by Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens. Both bids were submitted without a detailed breakdown of services to be performed. Countryside Service's bid was \$122,042.22 and Boston John Heating and Cooling was \$198,000.00. Commissioner Pickens stated that the bids would be reviewed and they will be notified in a few days as to their decision.

The Commission thanked both companies for submitting a bid.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 30, 2014.


