

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
TUESDAY, JUNE 7, 2016  
15TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 7, 2016 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Adair County Public Library Director, Jami Livingston. Mrs. Livingston asked that the Commission reappoint Matt Heeren to the Adair County Public Library Board. She stated that he had expressed an interest to continue to serve on the board. He was an asset to the board and was an active board member. The Commission stated they would consider her recommendation and contact her in the near future with their decision.

At 2:00 p.m., the Commission met with Adair County Assessor, Donnie Waybill, to discuss the sale of information from the Geographical Information System (GIS). Mr. Waybill stated he had been contacted by Arnold Williams with the Information Technology Services Division for the State of Missouri. Mr. Williams wanted to purchase the aerial view of Adair County including parcel names. Mr. Waybill has negotiated a purchase price of \$3500. After discussion, Commissioner Thompson moved to sell the aerial view of Adair County with parcel names to the State of Missouri. Commissioner Adams seconded with all in favor. Mr. Waybill will contact Mr. Williams for preparation of a sale contract.

Mr. Waybill also discussed an inquiry by Adair County Rural Water to purchase the aerial view of Adair County with parcel names. It was discussed that Rural Water had donated used water towers over the years to the Road and Bridge Department that had been installed as culverts throughout the County resulting in huge savings to the Road and Bridge Department. Mr. Waybill stated he had discussed with Rural Water a price of \$500 plus \$100 for data transfer. Commissioner Adams moved to sell the aerial view of Adair County with parcel names to Adair County Rural Water. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion with all in favor. Mr. Waybill will contact Rural Water to confirm the selling price and prepare a sale contract if accepted.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 7, 2016.
