

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 8, 2016
16TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 8, 2016 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Perry Ferguson, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) – Missouri Division of Emergency Management, for the exit briefing of Disaster #4238. The incident period occurred May 15, 2015 to July 27, 2015 and involved severe storms, tornadoes, straight-line winds and flooding. The event(s) were officially declared a disaster by the federal government on August 7, 2015.

Total approved cost of the project(s) includes labor of \$20,791.95, equipment \$122,904.59, material \$1,433,466.60 for a total cost of \$1,577,163.14. FEMA will pay for damages up to \$1,577,163.14 of which Adair County is eligible for 75% reimbursement of the project costs. The remaining 25% or \$394,290.79 would be expense to the County. Paperwork can now be submitted to receive reimbursement for monies already expended by the Road and Bridge Department for repair to numerous roads of the County that had been flooded. Much work still remains to be completed.

Once the project is completed, there is a possibility that the County could be partially reimbursed by the State of Missouri for the 25% of expenditures not covered by FEMA.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commissioner Adams moved to reappoint Matt Heeren to the Adair County Public Library Board. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion with all in favor. Mr. Heeren has been appointed for another 4 year term.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 8, 2016.
