Sheriff Hardwick continued saying that Judge Steele was not dealing with amounts owed to the County as was Judge Swaim. Judge Swaim said everything was documented on Polycom (a software program used by the Court system) and thought that Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson, would have insight into this situation. It was noted that most qualify for the services of the public defender. She had also shared information from Michigan to the State of Missouri about garnishing wages to help inmates pay their bills. She didn't know, however, Judge Steele's reason as to who was required to pay board bills and those that would be waived.

Mr. Axsom stated the average stay for an inmate was 6 weeks. Time standards were not being met in the Circuit Court. Sheriff Hardwick wanted legislation to bring the Circuit Judges back in line. He said the State had one rate, but the County had several. He thought a comparison of the rates charged by the Circuit Court vs. the Associate Court would be good. Judge Swaim said she would provide the Sheriff with the information and would help in any way they could.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on March 17, 2014.

Order to Transfer Funds






