

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18, 2015
20TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 18, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Shannon Howe, Howe Company, to discuss ideas on how to obtain temporary easements to complete BRO #48 bridge project. The Commission stated that they had received a letter from one landowner not wanting to allow them a temporary easement.

Mr. Howe told the Commission that he felt that a meeting with all the landowners involved would be the best choice. This way they can discuss the project and the benefits to the landowners.





The Commission asked how the schedule was looking in regards to the bid process and Mr. Howe said he felt the County would receive several bids.

At 3:30 p.m., the Commission moved to transfer \$1000 from General Revenue – Transfers Out-Temporary Loan to Child Support Enforcement 101-5-025-700.000 to Child Support Enforcement – Temporary Loan from General Revenue 905-4-000-600.400 in order to cover payroll. This will allow Child Support Enforcement (Multi County) to maintain their operation of services until reimbursement is received from the State of Missouri with eventual repayment to Adair County. Commissioner Thompson motioned to make the transfer. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Pickens was in favor.


The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on March 18, 2015.
