

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**WEDNESDAY, MARCH 25, 2015**  
**23RD DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 25, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Sheriff Hardwick presented the Commission with a budget amendment proposal for an additional \$4000 in fund 805 and requested that they vote on it. Since the item was not listed on the agenda and in order to give proper notice to the public, a vote could not be taken on the issue at this time. Sheriff Hardwick explained that the amendment had been discussed before and now he had the legal opinion to support the refunding of excess fees charged for conceal carry permit applications. The Sheriff's Department had been charging \$130.50 per application and the legal opinion stated that only a maximum charge of \$100.00 could be collected.

Due to the confidentiality of the applicants, the budget will need to be amended in order for the \$4,000 to be expensed from the County Treasury and deposited into the Sheriff's fee account. The Sheriff's Department will then be able to issue refunds of \$30.50 to each person that applied for a conceal carry permit from August 2013 to present. The budget amendment has been scheduled for March 30, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.

The Adair County Commission held a bid opening for replacement windows on the third floor of the Courthouse. Those present included Presiding Commissioner Stanley Pickens; 1<sup>st</sup> District Commissioner Carson Adams; 2<sup>nd</sup> District Commissioner Mark Thompson; Jeff Crist, Aladdin Glass; and Ed Ross, Beards Glass & Metals.

The bid opening began at 2:03 pm with Presiding Commissioner Pickens opening the bid submitted by Beards Glass & Metal. Beards submitted a bid of \$52,600.00 including installation but screens would be a separate purchase. The second bid was submitted by Aladdin Glass in the amount of \$44,700.00 installation and screens included.

The Commission thanked Mr. Crist and Mr. Ross for coming and told that they would contact them with their decision.

The Commission discussed the bids and 1<sup>st</sup> District Commissioner Carson Adams moved to accept the bid submitted by Aladdin Glass. 2<sup>nd</sup> District Commissioner Mark Thompson seconded the motion with all in favor.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on March 25, 2015.
