

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**WEDNESDAY, MARCH 29, 2017**  
**23RD DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 29, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner King and Commissioner Thompson were present. Commissioner Thompson will be acting Presiding Commissioner during the absence of Presiding Commissioner Pickens.

The Commission discussed the appointment of a new E911 board representative. It was felt that the individual should not only represent the County but also outside agencies within the County.
