## ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES MONDAY, MARCH 31, 2014

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Mrs. Macomber also wanted to clarify the information provided to Sheriff Hardwick concerning the telephone reimbursement request from the City which included costs incurred on behalf of the Sheriff's department. When the Joint E911 was established in 2000, AT&T telephone circuits needed to be purchased and maintained with a monthly fee. The billing had originally been coded incorrectly by the telephone company and has been billed to the City ever since. The fee started at approximately \$20 but had risen over time. From September 2012 through March 2014 the bill increased to \$574.80 a month. The error had only recently been discovered. As a result, the City had asked Sheriff Hardwick for reimbursement of \$7,961 to help offset these costs.

Commissioner Mark Thompson mentioned that he had noticed some structures being built close to the approach to the airport. The County does not have building ordinances in place, but the airspace in that vicinity is controlled by the FAA and anyone wanting to build in that area would need to contact them.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:30 p.m. on March 31, 2014.
