

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY, MARCH 6, 2017
12TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 6, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner King and Commissioner Thompson were present. Commissioner Thompson will be acting Presiding Commissioner during the absence of Presiding Commissioner Pickens.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission attended the ribbon cutting ceremony for Viva Italia, an Italian restaurant opening in Kirksville.

Commissioner Thompson signed the "Resolution to Appoint" two members of the County governing body to the solid waste management council and one member of the County governing body as an alternate. Mark Thompson and Stanley Pickens will represent the County of Adair on the Northeast Missouri Solid Waste Management Council. Bill King, also being a member of the governing body, will represent the County as an alternate Council member.

The Commission sent a letter to Adair County Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson, requesting that he file a Motion for Change of Judge for Case Number: 17-AR-CV00013 Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System vs. the City of Kirksville and Adair County.
