

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY, MARCH 7, 2016
15TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 7, 2016 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

In accordance with the employee manual weapons policy on page 64, the Adair County Commissioners gave written consent for Public Administrator, Rhonda Noe, to carry a concealed weapon inside the County owned Annex building. They believed this was an appropriate action as they felt her job duties required her to maintain effective self-defense if needed, especially since she could not rely on the Sheriff's Department for adequate protection. This was by proof of an incident in the Administrator's office where her panic button was used due to a consumer demonstrating aggressive and threatening actions toward the Administrator and her staff. The Sheriff's Department did not show up in a timely manner even though located across the road from the Public Administrator's office.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on March 7, 2016.

Re: *Written Consent Regarding Weapons Policy*

In accordance with the employee manual weapons policy on page 64, the Adair County Commissioners, are giving written consent for Public Administrator Rhonda Noe, to carry a concealed weapon inside the County owned Annex building.

We believe this is an appropriate action, as we feel her job duties require her to maintain effective self-defense if needed, especially since she cannot rely on the Sheriff's Department for adequate protection, by proof of the incident in the Administrator's office where her panic button was used due to a consumer demonstrating aggressive and threatening actions toward the Administrator and her staff. It is important to note that the Sheriff's Department did not show up in a timely manner. This was disappointing since the Department is just across the road from the Public Administrator's office.

As a result of this incident, we feel Mrs. Noe should be allowed to carry a concealed weapon.
