The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 9, 2016 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Pickens and Commissioner Adams were present. Commissioner Thompson was absent.

At the request of Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick, Commissioner Adams moved to transfer \$168,969.00 from the Law Enforcement Services account (301-5-001-400.000) to the Law Enforcement General account (801-4-000-700.200). This amount will cover salaries and other expenses through the end of the first quarter of 2016. Presiding Commissioner Pickens seconded the motion.

The Commission inspected County roads which included Flint Trail that needed rock; Glenview Trail that needed rock; Igloo Trail that needed grading and rock; and Remington Trail that also needed rock.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.


