## ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES MONDAY, MAY 16, 2016 6TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on May 16, 2016 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Stanley Pickens and 1<sup>st</sup> District Commissioner, Carson Adams were present. 2<sup>nd</sup> District Commissioner Thompson was absent.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, presented two quotes for the Commission's review for repairs/upgrades to the Juvenile Justice fire alarm and sprinkler system. These were obtained by Pat Williams, Court Services Administrator, as a result of a recent annual inspection by the Fire Marshall. Mr. Williams was inquiring if these expenses qualified as capital improvements to the facility they are currently housed in and owned by Adair County.

After review, Mrs. Collop was asked to obtain a copy of the inspection for the smoke detectors from Mr. Williams. This could possibly be a capital expenditure, but wanted additional information. The quote for the annual inspection of the sprinkler system represents a maintenance procedure and they feel it does not qualify as a capital expenditure. Mr. Williams will be notified of their review.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on May 16, 2016.
