

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

WEDNESDAY, MAY 16, 2012
7TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30a. m. on May 16, 2012 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with members of the Adair County Soil and Water Conservation District. Attending were John Robinson, Ron Weber, Jennifer Schutter, Shawn Robertson, and Bob Jackson. The County entered into an agreement to insure that the citizens of Adair County would have ample opportunity to participate in soil conservation measures. The agreement also promised to promote soil conservation measures along with promoting the cost-share program and the loan-interest share assistance program sponsored by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. In exchange for the Adair County Soil and Water Conservation District providing the above programs, Adair County promised to pay Adair County Soil and Water Conservation District \$1,000.00.

A check in the amount of \$1000 was awarded to the district. They expressed their appreciation to the Commission and said they would put the money to good use. The district will be hosting a Lady Landowners Appreciation Day on May 30, 2012 and a Landowners Appreciation Day and Election on June 20, 2012.

At 1:00 p. m., the Commission met with Adair County Library Director, Glenda Hunt, to discuss the replacement of Mark Laughlin as a board member. Ms. Hunt and the Commission will ask for letters of interest from citizens who would like to become a board member.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, notified the Commission that Daniel Jones & Associates will return to the County for two days, July 5 and 6, to complete the State required financial audit for 2010 and 2011.

The Commission spent the rest of the day reviewing requests for proposals of engineering qualifications for BRO 48. This will include the building for four small bridges on Banner Lane, Fox Trot Lane, Benton Road, and Oklahoma Trail. The Commission will send their evaluations to the Missouri Department of Transportation.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00p.m. on May 16, 2012.
