

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

WEDNESDAY, MAY 23, 2012
10TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30a.m. on May 23, 2012 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Shannon Howe of Benton & Associates engineering firm. Mr. Howe presented a graph comparing unit prices charged by Oden Enterprises for steel used to build bridges on Oklahoma Trail, Cinder Way, Merl Road, and Benton Road. The comparison indicated that the price for piling for the bridge on Benton Road was not consistent with the prices charged for the other bridges. The Commission will contact Oden Enterprises regarding the price differences.

Mr. Howe then presented contracts for design and construction engineering for four additional bridges to be built in Adair County. These bridges included Banner Lane, Foxtrot Lane, Oklahoma Trail, and a second location on Benton Road. He stated that the design phase of each bridge would be \$45,000 with the construction phase engineering being \$23,000 per bridge. This included the cost of asbestos and lead based paint inspection. If all four bridges were contracted for designing at the same time, he was able to give a \$12,000 savings on the total package. The cost would then be reduced to \$260,000 from \$272,000 for all four bridges. It would be advertised as one project with one contractor building all four bridges. He stated there would be adequate BRO funding to cover the additional estimated cost of \$600,000 to build the four bridges.

Commissioner Thompson stated that the signing of contracts should be an agenda item for the Commission and postponed the signing until May 29, 2012 at 8:30a.m. Sandra Collop, Adair County Clerk, asked Mr. Howe to provide an updated report from the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) of Adair County BRO funds and estimated future allocations. Mr. Howe stated he would return on Tuesday, May 29, with the contracts and an updated report of BRO funding.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00p.m. on May 23, 2012.
