The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on May 25, 2016 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, informed the Commission she had been contacted by Attorney Scott Summers regarding payment of special prosecuting attorney fees ordered by the court for case no. 08AR-CR00412. The Commission will contact Matt Wilson, Prosecuting Attorney, for the status of this situation.

Mrs. Collop also reported she had spoken with Mari Macomber, Kirksville City Manager, regarding the Downtown Tax Increment Finance (TIF) Economic Activity Tax and the South 63 TIF Economic Activity Tax. She and Mrs. Macomber reviewed a Memorandum of Understanding Regarding TIF Payments between the City of Kirksville and Adair County. The agreement that was drafted in October, 2011 was never signed by either entity.
