

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, MAY 26, 2015
10TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on May 26, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present. The Adair County Courthouse was closed on Monday, May 25, 2015 in observance of Memorial Day.

The Commission traveled to Macon County to attend a Board of Equalization (BOE) workshop. The workshop was presented by Maureen Monaghan of the Missouri State Tax Commission and highlighted changes to the assessment process.

The County received a check in the amount of \$439.20 from Ameren for reimbursement for 48 tons of rock for the repair of road damage to Bee Lane (f/k/a) Spencer Lane. In turn, the Commission signed a damage release that unconditionally released Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois, from any claims, which accrued to Bee Lane which is owned and maintained by Adair County, Missouri.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on May 26, 2015.
