Ameren will be co-hosting meetings with Ameren to explain this proposal to the citizens. Meetings are tentatively scheduled to be held in Palmyra on June 13, Edina on June 14 and in Kirksville on June 15th. They would then come back to the County Commission in the second week of July for a route approval with the assent and an agreement specifically addressing roads. A letter will be sent to possible affected property owners referring to co-locating of existing right-of-ways.

These meetings will be addressed differently with a presentation then a question and answer session. Commissioner Thompson was concerned with how the public was treated at the first set of meetings held by Ameren. Some people had been escorted out of the meetings when asking questions and there was a presence of Law Enforcement.

The meeting then came to a close with the agreement that the Commission would be happy with having the Zachary substation re-located near to the Adair substation or on Co-op right-of-way.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on May 3, 2017.

The Adair County Courthouse will be closed on Monday, May 8, 2017 in observance of Truman's birthday.


