

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2013  
3RD DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on November 6, 2013 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Commissioner Thompson moved to accept the list of 2014 Adair County Holidays. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. They include: Wednesday, January 1, 2014 – New Year's Day; Monday, January 20, 2014 – Martin Luther King Jr. Day; Wednesday, February 12, 2014 – Lincoln Day; Monday, February 17, 2014 – Washington's Birthday; Thursday, May 8, 2014 – Truman Day; Monday, May 26, 2014 – Memorial Day; Friday, July 4, 2014, Independence Day; Monday, September 1, 2014 – Labor Day; Monday, October 13, 2014 – Columbus Day; Tuesday, November 11, 2014 – Veterans Day; Thursday, November 27, 2014 – Thanksgiving Day; Friday, November 28, 2014 – Day after Thanksgiving; Wednesday, December 24, 2014 – Christmas Eve (afternoon); Thursday, December 25, 2014 – Christmas Day; and Day after Christmas, December 26, 2014.

Adair County Sheriff Hardwick cancelled review of the food service contracts. It will be rescheduled at a later date.

In the afternoon, the Commission met with Adair County Health Director, Jim LeBaron, on site at the location of the land the Health Department is requesting from the County.

The County's current election of the County paying 2% and the employee paying 2% for the County Employees' Retirement Fund (CERF) will remain in effect during 2014.

The Commission checked the area of Cranberry Lane at Miller's Saw Mill to see if logs were too close to the road. The Commission will be notifying the property owners that they will be required to remove their logs from the County's right of way.

One of the bridge railings had been removed from the bridge on Archer Trail. Locke Farms had taken the railing off to move equipment and would replace the railing in the near future.

One stock trailer and one utility trailer were discovered parked on the right of way of Michigan Trail. The property owner will be notified to remove the equipment.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 6, 2013.
