WHEREAS, the Adair County O.A.T.S. Committee is committed to providing reliable transportation to disadvantaged citizens of Adair County, Missouri.


WITNESSETH:

2. In exchange for the Adair County O.A.T.S. Committee providing the reliable transportation as stated above, Adair County promises to pay County O.A.T.S. Committee the sum of \$1,500.00.
3. The parties agree and acknowledge that this Agreement for Services is a memorialization of an oral agreement made and entered into by the parties on November 9, 2016.
4. The Adair County O.A.T.S. Committee further acknowledges receipt of \$1,500.00 from the Commissioners of Adair County, Missouri presented on behalf of the County of Adair on November 9, 2016.
