ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2012 5TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 10, 2012 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner Pickens was present. Commissioner Thompson participated in a KRES radio interview in the morning and then was in Kirksville. Commissioner Adams was out of town.

Commissioner Pickens met with Brent Barnhill of Employers Committed to Control Health Insurance Costs (ECCHIC). He was accompanied by Jeff Romine. Also present, was Human Resource/Grant Writer, Beth Platz; Adair County Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson; Adair County Treasurer, Lori Smith; Adair County Sheriff's Department—Operations Section Chief, Bill King; Finance Co-coordinator—Adair County Sheriff's Department, Melissa Hocker; and Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop.

Mr. Barnhill discussed different variations of aggregate deductibles. He felt the County would be better served with a lower aggregate deductible and a shorter time period. There were several questions asked concerning health care costs. The Commission thanked Mr. Barnhill for his presentation.

At the request of the Adair County Collector's Office, Commissioner Thompson moved to transfer funds from the Collector's Tax Maintenance Fund (704-5-001-200.000) in the amount of \$4,596.00 to General Revenue – Commission Office Expenses (101-5-001-100.000) in the amount of \$3,447.00 and to General Revenue – Human Resource Office Expenses (101-5-014-100.000) in the amount of \$1,149. Commissioner Pickens seconded the motion. This will purchase new desks for the Adair County Commission and the Human Resource/Grant Writer.

At the request of the Adair County Sheriff's Office, Commissioner Thompson moved to transfer funds from Law Enforcement Services (301-5-001-400.00) to Law Enforcement General (801-4-000-700.200) in the amount of \$62,100.00. Commissioner Pickens seconded the motion.

The Commission met with Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick to sign an amendment to the food service contract between Adair County Missouri and CBM Food Service. The new contract year will be November 1, 2012 thru October 31, 2013.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on October 10, 2012.
