BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the doors of the Commission office. Present at the meeting were Presiding Commissioner Pickens; Commissioner Thompson; Adair County Treasurer, Lori Smith; Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop; and by telephone Adair County Legal Counsel, Ivan Schraeder of the Lowenbaum Partnership, L.L.C. So motioned by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Pickens approving at 9:05 a.m. on Thursday, October 10, 2013.

Open session resumed at 10:01 a.m.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 10:01 a.m.
