ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES TUESDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2015 4TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 13, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Pickens, Commissioner Adams, and Commissioner Thompson were present. The Courthouse was closed on Monday, October 12, 2015 in observance of Columbus Day.

The Commission met with Howe & Company for the Pre-Construction Conference on Bridge BRO 49. Those present were: Shannon Howe, Howe & Company; Ron Watts, Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT); 2nd District Commissioner, Mark Thompson; 1st District Commissioner, Carson Adams; Brad Parn, Brookfield Box & Bridge, LLC; Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens; and Betty Powell, Adair County Deputy Clerk.

Brookfield Box & Bridge, LLC will be removing the existing bridge and constructing a new 70'-0" single span, steel girders, concrete bridge deck with steel foundation piles, concrete abutments, SL – 1 guardrail and all appurtenances. The construction will begin on October 13, 2015 with an anticipated completion of winter 2015/2016.

Brad Parn from Brookfield Box & Bridge said that he has a crew of 3 to 4 that will be assisting with this project and is ready to get started.

Ron Watts with MoDOT told the Commission that he has worked with Brad Parn as the contractor on other projects and he is very good to work with.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on October 13, 2015.
