

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

**MONDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2012
6TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 15, 2012 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Commissioner Thompson moved to amend the current budget to reflect an increase in expenses for the line item Drug Court Transfer 907-5-003-902.200 in the amount of \$3,500.00. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. This will allow the Juvenile Justice Center to cover expenditures from the Drug Court checkbook. There will not be corresponding revenues for this additional expense.

Commissioner Thompson moved to amend the current budget to reflect an increase to the expense account 301-5-004-905.200 Law Enforcement Services - Deputy Sheriff Supplement Grant in the amount of \$8,134.02. There will also be an increase in the revenue account 301-400.400.000 Law Enforcement Services - Deputy Sheriff Supplement Grant in the amount of \$7,189.20. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. This is due to the grant award of the Deputy Sheriff's Salary Supplementation Fund to the Adair County Sheriff's Office. This will provide the Adair County Sheriff's Office with supplemental funds to be used for deputy salaries which will allow them to compete with other law enforcement agencies in recruiting and retaining qualified officers.

The Commission met with Shannon Howe of Benton & Associates to sign Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to an Engineering Services Contract. The Supplements Agreement will be made part of the agreement dated July 24, 2012 for design and construction inspection of project BRO-B001 (48). The purpose of the agreement was to delete and replace the Scope of Services section in the original contract.


