

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2013
6TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 15, 2013 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission met at the recently completed bridge on Campbell Cemetery Trail for final acceptance of the bridge. The bridge was built by Bleigh Construction Company of Hannibal, Missouri.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, informed the Commission that on October 11, 2013, Skip Wilson, District Bridge Inspection Technician, from the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) delivered four Adair County maps, a map book, and a county road inventory report that listed each county road, its length and surface type. Adair County's proposed county road mileage is 661.69. Commissioner Pickens was in agreement with the completed maps and report and will return a signed map back to Mr. Wilson. The map book and CD containing the map will be housed at the Road and Bridge Department.

Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick, presented a signed contract from the Missouri Department of Transportation (Traffic and Highway Safety Division) for a Click It or Ticket project. The project obligates \$3,000 in federal funds for the period of October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014. Commissioner Pickens originally signed the grant on September 30, 2013.

The Commission received notification from Trident Insurance Company, the County's current property and casualty carrier, that the State has required them to provide notice of potential premium renewal changes with regard to our insurance policy.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:30 p.m. on October 15, 2013.
