The Commission met with Seth Shumaker, a former attorney of Adair County, to discuss his availability to research information for the Commission. The Commission told Mr. Shumaker that policies have been in place for a number of years regarding the judicial system within the County. They stated that it had come to their attention that some of these policies may not be in the best interest of the County. They were needing assistance in determining what is in the best interest of the County.

Discussion was held regarding the potential creation of a budget consultant position to help with their research. Mr. Shumaker stated he would be interested in obtaining such a position with the County. Commissioner Thompson moved to hire Mr. Shumaker to conduct research for the County. He will receive payment of \$20,000 until December 31, 2013. He will then receive \$5,000 a month for January and February, 2014. It will be determined at that time if his services will be need to be continued.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:30 p.m. on October 23, 2013.
