

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2015
9TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 26, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The County Commission attended the semi-annual Commissioners and Clerks meeting hosted this fall by Clark County on October 23, 2015.

The Commission hosted the Eight Annual Adair County Government Day sponsored by the American Legion, MacDougall/Lowe Post No. 20. Tours of the County offices began at 9:00 a.m. with students from the Adair County R-I School in Novinger and teacher, Dan Sullivan. The Adair County – 2nd Judicial Circuit also participated in the event. Government Day ended at 12:15 p.m.

The Commission sent a written notice to the residents of 21678 Potter Road in Kirksville to remove personal property from the County's road right-of-way. Any person placing any object within a County right-of-way is in violation and shall be responsible for the removal of the object at the owner's expense within thirty days of receipt of this written notice. Failure to comply with the notice will result in the process being turned over to the Prosecuting Attorney.

The Commission extended a written apology to the residents of 21682 Potter Road in Kirksville for previously sending a letter to their address regarding removal of personal property from County right-of-way.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on October 26, 2015.
